

BOXERS MUST DO THEIR BEST

King's Bench Division Upholds Ruling and Referee's Disqualification.

LONDON, Dec. 31.—Boxers in this country and those who follow the game will be latterested in a decision by the King's Bench Division, in which in dismissing an appeal from the decision of a judge of the Westminster County Court, Justices Darling and Bucknill, upheld the action of the referee at the National Sporting Club in disqualifying Jack Goldswain for "not trying" in a contest held in the club house last March.

The contest, was for the welterweight

last March.

The contest was for the welterweight championship, and by the terms of the agreement entered into by the boxers it was arranged that each should put up fill, and that fill should be added by the club. Of this sum the winner was to have fill and the loser fol. It was also arranged that each man should be allowed fill for training expenses, but that in the event of either man "not trying" he should receive nothing, the agreement further providing that the decision of the referee should be final, and not subject to an appeal in any court of law.

Goldswain was disqualified in the 11th round, and then brought an action against the National Sporting Club for fill due him as the loser, the sum of fill, which he said was the balance of fill due for training expenses, and for a further fill, which he alleged that his opponent had agreed should be deducted by the club and hand-

"I gather," said Justice Darling later, "that it is the duty of a putilist who up.

"that it is the duty of a puglist who undertakes to fight to go on committing assault and battery as fast and hard as possible. Occasionally he refuses to do this, and becomes a peaceable citizen. He hangs upon the neck of the other combatant and then this is objected by the referee and others who come to see the fight. He is accordingly ordered to resume assault and battery, and if he does not do it he is disqualified—for being a peaceful citizen." (Laughter.) takes to fight to go on committing as

Mr. Lesile Scott explained that the case arose out of a 20-round boxing contest for the welterweight championship. Goldswain was unfortunately knocked about rather badly in the tenth and eleventh rounds, and the contest was then stopped by the referee, who disqualified him. The plaintiff was "punished" so much that in the eleventh round he was said to have been "holding" his opponent.

The referee, in his evidence, said he saw Goldswain was not "doing his best," and disqualified him.

The judges intimated that in their opinion the referee had full power to decide if the man was "trying" and they dismissed the appeal. Judge Da ling said the county court judge was right in his view that the referee had the exclusive power to decide whether or not a man should be disqualified for "not trying," and consequently deprived of any part of the purse.


