being duly sworn, is examined by the prosecutor,
and states:-

"I am Transport accountant, H.Q., M.D.No.13. On
31st May, 1940, I issued Travelling Warrant #5362
covering return transport Calgary to Edmonton for
escort party - Cpl. Marsh, Private Batty, Warrant
also covered transportation from Edmonton to Calgary
for M-16788 Pte. Elkowich, G. Edmonton Regiment,
and one other prisoner, the total value of the Warrant
being \$19.50. Travelling Claim covering expenses
of escort party, amounting to \$4.25 has been passed
for payment. I know of no other transportation ex-
penses in this case."

Q.7 "Total of \$23.75 covered the cost of transportation
of the accused and one other prisoner?"

A.7 "Yes, sir".

Q.8 "Therefore, it is reasonable to suppose \$11.88 should
be charged against the accused as the cost of his
return to Calgary?"

A.8 "Yes, sir".
