

Current Comment

The first strike in the United States is said to have been that of bakers in New York, who combined and struck for increased pay 162 years ago.

The American Federation of Labor has now 3,175 commissioned organizations in the field reporting active work.

In Philadelphia the Pennsylvania factory inspectors rigidly prevent the manufacture of clothing in any house not sanitary and having 4 doors.

Cotton mills in New England, employing about 30,000 operatives, which either were shut down or running on short time for several months, have gone on full time schedules.

The act imposing \$200 upon every Chinese entering Canada has had no practical effect. Since January no Chinese have come to this country, with the exception of two who escaped from steamships.

It is quite possible for a consistent union man to belong to one of the political parties, but he is certainly not progressive, and no unionist should use that this class of politician is not heretical forth in the bill boards and in newspaper reports of meetings as a "promise of labor men."

It is not somewhat humiliating to the rest of the trade candidates for Parliament in Toronto and South York that five were lawyers, and not one of them in the front rank of the mental prostitute brigade! While the people are content to be "represented" by lawyers, we show plainly that they are "out for the stuff."

All men believe and repeat that equality of conditions is identical with equality of rights; that property and robbery are synonymous terms; that every social advantage accorded, or rather usurped, in the name of superior talent or service, is iniquity and extortion. P. J. Proudhon.
