NEWS SUMMARY.

—The rainy season has opened in Mexico, and brought with it an epidemic of small-pox. Many deaths have occurred.
—The deepest hole in the world is bored at Schladebach, Germany. It is 3735 feet in depth, and is for geological research only.
—The lobster factory of James Houlahan, at Berryhead Cove, Bonne Bay, on the west coast, has been raided by the British warship Buzzard. Boiler and boats were removed and the factory was burnt. The warship then suddenly left. The lobster business at that point in Newfoundland is now dead.

—Mr. Medway's motion at the Trade Congress in London to the effect that a league union between Great Britain and her colonies by preferential duties being based upon protection would be dangerous and commercially disastrous, and that an arrangement that would best conduce to intimate commercial union would be for the self-governing colonies to adopt as closely as circumstances permit the non-protective policy of Great Britain, was carried by a vote of 47 chambers to 34.

—The Medical Association Maritima Provinces held its annual session at Halifax last week. The dance was large. The society entertained at an "at home" by the Rev. Mr. Grant...

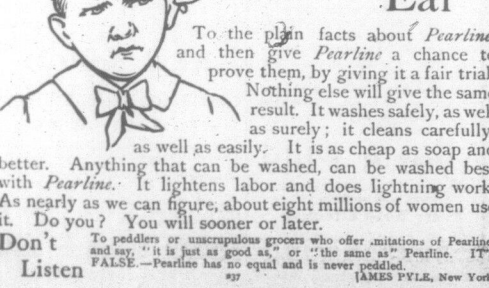
