Author's Experience in Stone Pile of Deleware Jail to be Followed by State Wide Bat-

Arden, Del., August 12.-From the squabble in the single tax colony here, which led to the incarceration of Upton Sinclair and nine other jeading citizens of that colony in the county jail, is about to grow a Stafewide movement for the wining from the statutes of the blue laws of 1793; but of far greater importance is a second movement which will be taken up to make the prisons fit for human beings, however low they have

human beings, however low they have fallen, to live in.

The ten Adrenites forgot the humor of a situation which had all the elements of a farce comedy in studying the more serious aspects of the case; on Thursday night it was decided to organize an "anti-blue law" society; the fight against prison conditions will be Sinclair's own.

The incident smashed some choice theories; it showed an anarchist boldly proclaiming a love for the law; and it showed that even a community which tries to get along without courts or police must eventually acknowledge of that the power of the law is needed.
