**Synopsis of Canadian North-
west Land Regulations.**
The sale of land of a family, or any male over 18
years of age, who was at the commencement of the
present war, and has since continued to be a British
subject or subject of an allied or neutral country,
may homestead a quarter-section of available
Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, or
Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at
Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for Dis-
trict. Entry by proxy may be made on certain
conditions. (Under this method residence on and
cultivation of land in each of three years.)
In certain districts a homestead may secure
an adjoining quarter-section as pre-emption.
In each of three years after entering homestead
pre-emption, the homesteader must reside on the
land and cultivate 50 acres. May obtain
certain conditions.
