

RATE INCREASE DECIDED UPON

Should Their Schedule Go Railroad Labor Will Not Get Its Demands.

New York, July 8.—According to a newspaper report the I. C. C. has practically decided on rate increase of 30 per cent. in Eastern territory; 24 per cent. in Western territory, and 31 per cent. in the Southern territory, making estimated earnings advance of something over one billion. The report states that this will be announced about July 15th, but that is a question as the labor board award is not expected until July 20th.

BRAZILIAN IN FLATTERING REPORT

Montreal, July 8.—Financial statement of Brazilian Traction, Light and Power Company for year to December 31, 1919, shows net revenue of \$7,873,967, an increase of \$2,464,395 as compared with 1918. After payment of \$400,000 in preferred dividends, there remained a surplus of \$7,373,967, equal to 6.85 p. c. on the \$106,470,800 of common stock. Current assets for the year are reported at \$16,371,197, against current liabilities of \$6,146,304. These figures compare with assets of \$13,702,980 and liabilities of \$10,025,836 in 1918.

BROMPTON TO INCREASE SHARES

Montreal, July 8.—At a meeting today Brompton Pulp and Paper Co. Ltd., shareholders ratified recommendation of directors that common capitalization, consisting of 70,000 shares of a par value of \$100 each, be increased to 210,000 of no par value, holders of the present stock to receive two shares of new securities for each one of the old held. The new shares will be placed on a six per cent. dividend basis, being the equivalent of 12 per cent. on the present stock.

TWO FACTIONS ON MARKET ACTIVE

Important New Developments Are Expected from Reading Soon.

New York, July 8.—There are two factions at work during the early market. Big operators who have been responsible for advance of last few days were still extremely bullish on the outlook, although somewhat inclined to shift from groups that had largest advances into others that have not fared so well during recent market advances. Reading is in high favor just now by those operators. One man in close touch with Reading situation expects important news developments on a distribution to stockholders during the next month. Some largest buyers of Reading, since Monday were responsible for move in Vanadium from 79 to above 93. Opposed to these interests bullish on the market were rank and file traders who took position recovery had gone far enough for present, and were selling stocks short.
