LIEUT.-GOV. PRIOR LAID TO REST


Federal and Provincial Legislatures Represented in Funeral at Victoria.

Victoria, B. C., Dec. 15—To the accompaniment of impressive ceremonial and with full military honor the remains of the late Lieutenant Governor Edward Gawior Prior were laid at rest in the family plot in Ross Bay cemetery this afternoon.

Representatives of the judiciary, the Dominion and provincial legislatures, the consulates, naval and military forces, returned soldiers organisations, fraternal societies and the general public joined in the cortege. The Bishop of Columbia, assisted by representatives of the Anglican clergy officiated at the service at Christ Church Cathedral and at the grave.




