

The second litter should come early in August and should be kept on the sow longer than the first litter; in fact quantities were three months old. About the end of September they should be fed some roots; they would not stay so fat if fed at first but they should be fed more roots and less grain. Sugar beets were the best winter food for young pigs. They should be cooked and mixed with the meal and served warm; the meal being added while the vegetables were still hot.
