BEVERIDGE, *Hon.* WILLIAM BLACKWOOD, *J.P.*

S. of Hon. Benj. Beveridge, late M.L.C. B., at Perth, Co. of Victoria, N.B., 16 Dec. 1835, and ed. at Mount Allison Coll., Sackville, N.B. M., Nov. 1862, Jane Elizabeth, dau. of Wm. Stevens, of Woodstock. Is a merchant. Was at one time Postmaster at Andover. Is a J.P. and a Major in the Reserve Militia. Was an unsuccessful candidate for Victoria in the Commons at g.e. 1867. First returned to Parlt. for that seat in Leg. Assem., N.B., at g.e. 1874, and re-elected at g.e. 1878. Apptd. to L.C., 25 May 1882. A Liberal.—*Andover, N.B.*

DAVIDSON, *Hon.* ALLAN A., *Q.C.*

Called to the Bar, N.B., 1840. Apptd. Q.C., 1875. An unsuccessful candidate for Northumberland in Leg. Assem., N.B., at g.e. 1870. First returned for Parlt. for seat in that Ho. at g.e. 1874; and re-elected at g.e. 1878. Apptd. to L.C. 25 May 1882. A Conservative.—*Newcastle, N.B.*

FLEWWELLING, *Hon.* JOHN.

A storekeeper, and was postmaster at Hampton Ferry. Is Treasurer King's Co. Board of Trade. Sat for King's in Leg. Assem. from 1866 until 1870, when defeated. An unsuccessful candidate for same seat, Oct. 1873. Again returned at g.e. 1874. Called to L.C., 3 May 1878. A Liberal.—*Hampton Ferry.*
