

PINEO, *Lieut.-Col.* HENRY GESNER, JR. [*Cumberland.*]

S. of Hon. H. G. Pineo, M.L.C. B. at Pugwash, N.S., 6 March, 1830. Ed. at Sackville, N. B. M., 1851, Charlotte Amelia, sec. dau. of J. N. B. Kerr, Esq., of Wallace. Apptd. United States Consular Agent, 1853, Swedish and Norwegian Vice Consul, 1859. Has been for a lengthened period an officer in the Volunteer Force, and was apptd. Lieut.-Col. Reserve Militia, 1869. First returned to Parl. for present seat at g.e., 1867. Re-elected at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Pugwash.*

RETTIE, SAMUEL, J.P. [*Colchester.*]

A merchant. Contested Colchester unsuccessfully at g.e., 1867. First returned at last g.e. by acclamation. A Conservative.—*Truro.*

ROBERTSON, *Hon.* ROBERT. [*Shelburne.*]

S. of the late William Robertson, formerly New York, and latterly of Barrington, N.S. U.E. loyalist, by Sarah, dau. of Gabriel V. Norden. Apptd. a mem. of Ex. Council, Nov., 1867, and was Commissioner of Public Works and Mines from that date until April, 1871. Sat for Barrington (Township) for years; and for present seat since g.e., 1867.

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
