An Act to amend the Gas Inspection Act.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :---

1. Subsection 1 of section 36 of The Gas Inspection Act, R.S.C., c. 101, 5 chapter 101 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 s. 36 amended. of chapter 26 of the statutes of 1896, is repealed and the fol-

lowing is substituted therefor:—

"36. Every undertaker shall keep the public informed of Certificate of the illuminating power of the gas supplied by him, and of its quality to be 10 purity as affected by the absence or presence of sulphuretted hydrogen, by procuring a certificate from the inspector and posting it up in the chief office of the undertaker from time to

time, as follows: Undertakers having more than four thousand Frequency of meters shall procure such certificate once in each week; those according to

15 having less than four and more than three thousand meters, number of once in two weeks; those having less than three and more consumers. than two thousand meters, once in each month; those having less than two thousand and more than one thousand meters, once in each interval of two months; and those having less

20 than one thousand meters, once in each interval of three months."
