- (a) Idleness.
- (b) ~~Disobedient~~ Opposition to authority.
- (c) Habitual ~~and~~ ~~neglect~~ neglect of duty.
- (d) The use of profane or improper language.
- (e) General bad conduct or ~~bad~~ example.
- (f) Cutting, marring, destroying or injuring any of the School property. — ~~The Teacher~~

The Teacher shall, upon suspending any pupil, give notice thereof in writing, to the parent or guardian, and to the Trustees, stating the reason for such suspension.

- (3) He shall exercise ~~the~~ <sup>proper</sup> ~~strict~~ vigilance over ~~the~~ School property under his charge, and give prompt notice in writing to the Trustees, of any <sup>required</sup> repairs ~~which may be needed or of supplies which may be required~~ <sup>or supplies</sup> for the School.

- (4) He shall give strict attention to the ventilation, ~~of~~ temperature, & cleanliness, of the School House, and shall also see that the outbuildings are kept in a clean and proper condition.
