New Jersey &c. has Directed us to send a fit Person to the Garrison
at Swecgo who understands Whick and bleeding, and bring Inform
that you are a person well skilled in these arts: These are therefore
by Virtue of a Letter Received from his Said Excellency So desire
and Require you to go to Swecgo as Chirurgion for the said Garrison
as soon as may be with such Proper Medicines as we can now supply
you with att Present, and take under your Care for the time and space
of one Year from the date hereof such sick men which now are or shall
be there belonging to his Majesties Garrison, for which Service
you are to be paid as per Agreement with us by the Government or by
his Said Excellency the sume of sixty pounds new york money.
Given under our hands in Albany the 16th Day of July in the
Second Year of his Majesties Reign ann^o 1720.
