COMMITTEE ON MUNITIONS AND FOOD SUPPLIES.

TECHNICAL SUB-COMMITTEE.

Composition and Terms of Reference.

1. At the First Meeting of the Committee on Munitions and Food Supplies, held on 28th May, 1937, it was agreed that a Technical Sub-Committee should be set up with the following terms of reference:-

- (a) To exchange and discuss technical information as to the requirements of Armaments and Munitions of War of the United Kingdom, the Dominions and India.
- (b) To consider to what extent it would be desirable for His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom, the Dominions and India to place orders for armaments and munitions of war with one another in order to assist them to develop their respective capacities for the manufacture of armaments and munitions of war.
- (c) To render a report to the Committee on Munitions and Food Supplies.
