Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 4th instant, I beg to say that this Department received the pay-lists of the distribution of annuity money for 1923 to Indians of the Port Churchill and Fork Factory Bands. The said pay-lists were made out on sheets of paper instead of in books, such as are provided for the purpose. I have to request therefore that you will be good enough to have the person who will make payment in future apply to this Department for the necessary blank pay-list books. When the payments are made the pay-lists should be prepared in duplicate. The original should be sent to this Department and the copy should be kept, for reference purposes in the office of the paying officer.

I may add that this Department has pay-lists bound in one large volume. This is done annually. You will understand therefore that it is necessary to have the lists of uniform size.
