Sir,-

I am directed to order from you ten (10) thoroughbred Shorthorn Bulls and 12 Heifers to be delivered at the Railway Stations mentioned not later than the 15th May next for the sum of \$125.00 each for the Bulls and \$27.00 each for the Heifers.

The Bulls must be Manitoba or North West bred, registered pedigree animals, not under 12 months nor over 3 years of age, first class in every respect and pass inspection as sound and of good quality.

Mr. S. A. Coxe of Brandon will inspect them so therefore kindly notify the Department at what point in Manitoba or the North West Territories the Bulls will be before shipment so that they can be inspected.

The heifers must be first class two year old grades in calf and must be acceptable to the Indian Agent before being taken over.

The oxen must not be under four nor over six years of age, free from bodily defects, in good condition and thoroughly broken.

All expenses in connection with delivery including transport are to be borne by you.

The pedigree should be handed to the Indian Agents together with your account.
