Rev. Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 11th instant returning Departmental letter of August 10th. Owing to a clerical error that letter referred to the Lac la Ponge Boarding School instead of the Lac la Ronge Boarding School.

In reply to your letter I beg to say that your school is the property of your Church and according to the agreement now in force between the Church and the Department, supplies such as fire equipment should be purchased by the Church authorities. You should, therefore, communicate immediately with them and endeavor to have the necessary fire appliances installed at once.
