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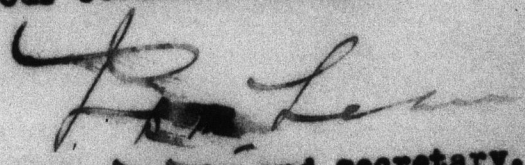
Ottawa, May 4, 1914.

Sir,-

In connection with the erection of a new hospital at Norway House, it is just possible that the equipment now in use there will not fully meet the requirements for the new building, I would, therefore, ask you to have the Doctor prepare a list showing the present equipment and note the deficiencies, giving full and detailed specification of the articles required. It is the intention of the Department to provide an equipment adequate for the requirements there and one which will be most suitable for the work.

The list should be prepared and sent in at an early date that they may be ready for consideration and arrangement made for the providing of same while navigation is open during the season.
