Ottawa, 4th August 1916.

Sir,-

With reference to your report of the 13th January last Mo.13905 B.C.L. and 3105-2 B.C.L., a copy of which was forwarded to this Department, I beg to inform you that the plan of the proposed Indian Reserve No.2-A, Skuppah, is very misleading. You may note that a red border indicating the limits of the reserve has been placed around the block which is stated to contain 43.67 acres. The right of way of the Canadian Pacific Railway which consists of all the land up to the mater's edge, is in error included in the block. The area of this right of way being 32.15 acres requires to be deducted, leaving only 11.52 acres (which you will note is in two portions) available as an Indian Reserve.
