I hereby make tender for the timber located on Mah-Ma-Lilli-Kulla, Reserve No. 1, containing 434.25 acres, with the privilege of removing the said timber within three years; this reserve being situated on Village Island and in your district.

Enclosed find certified cheque to the Receiver General of Canada covering 10% of my valuation of the timber at the rate of Three Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$3.75) per thousand, for six and one-half million feet (Board measure), all species, together with rental at the rate of 20¢ per acre for one year on 434.25 acres plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for license to log and operate on this Reserve.

Enclosed find certified cheque to the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy-Four Dollars and Thirty-Five Cents (\$2,574.35) which includes the three above items.
