Circular Letter

PLEASE REFER TO FILE NO. 516

August 17th, 1914.

Sir:

By direction of the Royal Commission on Indian Affairs for the Province of British Columbia, I have the honour to transmit herewith for your information and attention copy of a communication just received by the Commission from the Provincial Game Warden, and to express the regret of the Commissioners that Agents should have (as stated) failed to acknowledge the receipt of intimations as to regulations under the Game Act affecting their Indian wards, or neglected to communicate the contents of such regulations to the Indians under their care.

The Commission requests that the substance or effect of all such regulations affecting the rights and privileges of Indians under the Game Act and amendments thereto be promptly communicated to the Indians in order that they may govern themselves thereby.
