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*General Rules and Orders.*

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8TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1871.

I. Upon, from, and after this date, all Rules heretofore made, and now in force, regulating the practice and proceedings in civil cases in this Court are annulled ; and the following Rules made under the authority of the Consolidated Statute of Upper Canada, chapter thirteen, section sixty-four, are substituted for the same.

II. That, unless otherwise specially ordered, the security to be given in all cases of Error and Appeal, shall be personal, and by bond, and may be in the form given in the Rule numbered seven ; and shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Court appealed from, in Toronto.

III. That the security required by the Consolidated Statute of Upper Canada, chapter thirteen, section fifteen, shall be by bond to the respondent or respondents in the sum of four hundred dollars ; such bond to be executed by
