Attend to your greenhouse plants. Go on propagating plants by cuttings and slips. Transplant strawberries. This is the proper season for budding fruit trees. Cut off all supernumerary shoots from transplanted trees, and train the retained bearers of the next year. Take up your bulbous roots and dry them. Plant the roots again about October. Sow the seeds of bulbous roots in pots. If the weather is moist, transplant into borders your seedling biennials and perennials, which were sown early. In hot weather, shade the root with a garden pot through the day, which remove at night so that the plant may have the benefit of the dew. 23
