

The following is a List of the Disasters that happened out of over 1200 Vessels that came to Quebec the past season.

- Bark Fortitude, Garbutt, master, from London to Quebec, in ballast, drove on Prince Edward Island by the ice, 22nd April, and lost. All hands saved.
- Bark Mary Lang, Brown, master, from Sunderland to Quebec, with coals, lost off Eddystone Light House, 30th April. All hands saved.
- The Ophelia and Ann, Loveless, master, from Cardiff to Quebec, foundered in lat. 44, long. 43.
- Bark Royal Mint, Duncan, master, from Dundee to Quebec, lost 31st June, in lat. 53, long. 14. All hands saved.
- Portuguese schooner Santos Primero, from Oporto to Quebec, with a cargo of wine, wrecked on White Island, River St. Lawrence. Crew and cargo saved—vessel total loss.
- Ship Letitia Heyn, M'Wha, master, from Quebec to Liverpool, lost on the Magdalen Islands, entrance of the Gulf. Crew saved.
- Bark Abercromby, Loutit, master, from Liverpool to Montreal, with a general cargo, foundered in lat. 50 N., long. 28 W., about 15th September. Crew saved.
- Bark Jane, Bickford, master, from London to the Saguenay, wrecked about the middle of October, in Outard Bay, River St. Lawrence. Crew and materials saved.
- Ship Mountaineer, Crerar, master, from Liverpool to Quebec, abandoned in a sinking state, 3rd October, in lat. 49 N., long. 14 W. Crew saved.
- Bark Victory, McLeod, master, from Quebec to Plymouth, wrecked 26th October, at Little Metis, River St. Lawrence. Crew saved.
- Ship Pursuit, Murray, master, from Quebec to Liverpool, struck on Crane Island, River St. Lawrence, in the beginning of November and returned to Quebec, where she wintered.
- Ship Lochmaben Castle, Poole, master, from Quebec to London, lost on Anticosti—Gulf of St. Lawrence—14th October.—Crew saved.
- Ship Tyendenaga, Rudolf, master, from Quebec to London, lost at Caribou Island—Gulf of St. Lawrence, latter end of November.—17 of the Crew drowned—Vessel total loss.
- Ship Aberdeen, Dunn, master, from Quebec to Gloucester. went ashore at Kamouraska—River St. Lawrence, latter end of November.—Crew saved.
- Bark Sophia Burbidge, Richards, master, from Quebec to Liverpool, drove into River du Loup by the ice, latter end of November, where she wintered.
- Brig Galatea, March, master, from Quebec to Cardiff, lost on one of the Magdalen Islands, on 28th October.—One man lost—Materials saved.
