

24 **Saunders (F.)** THE STORY of the DISCOVERY of the NEW WORLD by COLUMBUS, compiled from accepted sources, *portrait and a facsimile of his first letter and other illustrations*, post 8vo, cloth, LARGE and FINE PAPER COPY, 1.25, London, 1892.

Ante-Columbian Explorers, and Early Life of Columbus, His Adventurous Voyage and Letter announcing his discovery, the close of his career and estimate of his character. THE ILLUSTRATIONS comprise a portrait, facsimile page about Prince Madoc, Columbus at the Convent Gate, his vessels on their course, his first sight of land, landing at San Salvador, facsimile page of his first letter and his monument at Genoa.

Includes a Description of the Gods of the Ancient Cilicians, broken up and by them on their Conversion to Christianity, first discovered and brought to light by the Author.

34 **Caricature HISTORY** of CANADIAN POLITICS, from: the Union of 1841, as illustrated by Cartoons from Grip and various other sources, by J. W.
