IV. An Act to continue an Act, intituled "An Act to provide for the accommodation and billeting of His Majefty's Troops, and the Militia when on their march."

V. An Act for the prefervation of Partridges.

VI. An Act for the better regulation of Licenfes to Inns, Taverns and Houfes for felling Strong Liquors by Retail.

VII. An Act further to continue for a limited time an Act, intituled "An Act for regulating, laying out and repairing Highways and Roads, " and for appointing Commissioners and Surveyors of Highways with-" in the leveral Towns and Parishes in this Province."

VIII. An Act in amendment of an Act, intituled "An Act to re-" peal all the Acts now in force relating to Trefpaffes, and for making " new regulations to prevent the fame."

IX. An Act to repeal an Act, intituled "An Act in alteration and amendment of an Act for establishing the Rates to be taken for Wharfage and Cranage," and for fubstituting other alterations and amendments of the fame Act therein recited in lieu thereof.

X. An Act for the Indemnification of Commissioners of Sewers.

XI. An Act to authorife the Rector, Church Wardens and Veftry of Saint Andrews' Church, in the Parifh of Saint Andrews, to convey to the King's Majefty, a certain piece of Glebe Land of the Parifh, for the purpose of erecting military fortifications thereon.
