CAP. I.

AN ACT to continue and amend the Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, imported into this Colony and its Dependencies.

[Passed 29th May, 1852.]

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the Thirteenth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, imported into this Colony and its Dependencies," which, as was therein declared, was to continue and be in force until the Thirtieth day of June, in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty One; and whereas by an Act passed in the Fourteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty, the said recited Act was continued in force for a further period, which will shortly expire, and it is expedient to continue the said Act for the period hereinafter limited: Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, that the said first recited Act passed in the Thirteenth Year of the reign of Her present Majesty, entitled "An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain Duties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize imported into this Colony and its Dependencies," and every clause, matter and thing therein contained, save and except as hereinafter provided, shall be and the same are hereby continued, in full force and effect, for One Year after the passing of this Act, any thing in the said recited Acts to the contrary notwithstanding. Continuance of 13th Vic., Cap. I.

II.—*And be it enacted*, That from and after the passing of this Act, there be levied, collected, and paid, upon every Hundred Weight of Fish, salted, dried, or pickled, imported into this Colony and its Dependencies, the duty of Five Shillings, which shall be levied, collected, and paid, in Duty of Five Shillings per cwt. on the importation of Fish, salted, &c.
