CAP. I.

*AN ACT further to Amend an Act passed in the Seventeenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act to Incorporate a Company under the Style and Title of the New York, Newfoundland and London Telegraph Company."*

[Passed 3rd March, 1857.]

**W**HEREAS the New York, Newfoundland and London Telegraph Company have applied to the Legislature of this Colony to Amend the Act passed in the Seventeenth Year of Her present Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act to Incorporate a Company under the Style and Title of the New York, Newfoundland and London Telegraph Company;" and it is deemed advisable to grant the application :

Preamble.

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, of Newfoundland, in Legislative Session Convened, as follows :—

I.—The said New York, Newfoundland and London Telegraph Company may, by Resolutions of their Board of Directors, Certified under their Corporate Seal, give to the Atlantic Telegraph Company Limited, constituted in England under the Provisions of an Act of the Imperial Parliament, entitled "the Joint Stock Companies' Act, 1856," the consent of the New York, Newfoundland and London Telegraph Company, that the said Atlantic Telegraph Company Limited, may extend their Sub-Marine Cable to, and touch and enter upon, this Island, with such Restrictions, and upon such Terms and Conditions, as may be agreed on between the said two Companies,

Power to join Transatlantic Sub-marine Electric Telegraph Cable to the Electric Telegraph line passing through this Island to the Continent of America..
