XIII. And We do hereby give and grant unto you full power and authority, as you shall see occasion, in Our name and on Our behalf, to grant to any Offenders convicted of any crimes in any Court, or before any Judge, Justice or Magistrate within Our said Island, a Pardon either free or subject to Lawful Conditions, or any Respite of the execution of the Sentence of any such Offenders, for such period as to you may seem meet, and to Remit any Fines, Penalties, or Forfeitures, which may become due and payable to Us.

XIV. And We do hereby require and command all Officers and Ministers, Civil and Military, and all others the Inhabitants of Oar said Island and its Dependencies, to be obedient, aiding and assisting unto you, the said Anthony Muserave, or, in the event of your death, incapacity, removal or absence from your Government, unto such person or persons, as may, under the provisions of this Our Commission, assume and exercise the Functions of Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over our said Island.

In Witness whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.

Witness Ourself, at Westminster, the Twenty-ninth day of August, in the Twenty-eighth Year of Our Reign.
