And be it also surther entitled, That is any Person of Persons shall from and after the Publication of this sict, presume directly or indirectly by themselves, or any Person acting under them, or by their Order, so tell any Isa Offe of Playing Cards, by any less Quantity than is here. Letter pier their, without is Anaking Enry of the Names and Places of Alade, gas by this Act is Cheered, He, Sie, or they shall, fix every such Offence on due Conviction thereof, by the Outh of one Credible Witness before any one of McMajesty's Justices of the Peace, for seit and Pây the Sunrot Ten Pounds, one Halts to be Poid to the Informer, and the other Half to be to His Majesty for thesuses mentioned in this Mot, which Fine shall be levied by Warrant of Different and Sale of the Offenders Goods and Charles, from under the I land and Seal of the Justice before whom such Conviction shall be made.

Provided always as dit is the True intent and meaning of this set, That it any Person who shall have enter'd their Names and Places of Abode as aforefaid, to sell any Tes, Ceffee, and playing Cards, shall Purchase either of the said Commodities in a less Quantity than is prescribed by this Act, from Persons whose Names are enter'd to sell the same, and shall within In Days after such Purchase, produce to the Collector or Receivers or Collectors of Receivers appearing, a Certificate from the Person from whom they Purchas'd the same, such Purchase shall not he held to pay the Duries on any Quantity to Purchas'd.

And be it enacted, That the Collector or Receiver, or Collectors or Receivers of the Duties for the Time being, shall reader a just Account and pay into the Hands of the Treasurer of the Province, all such Monies by hipsorthem Receiv'd in Pursuance of this Act, within

Thirty Days after the whole of each Quarter.

Fortgitures arting or accruing by this Act, shall and may be recovered by Bill. Plaint or Information, in any of his Majisty's Courts of Recovered his Province, and the Money arting from such Penalties and Forfeitures, attendeducting the Expences of Protecution, and all incident charges, shall be one Halfyto His Majesty for the Uses and Intents, for which the Duties are granted, and the other Half to him or them, who shall seize or inform, and Sue for the same,

En And be Walfo further enacted, That the Monies arising from the Dunes imposed by this Act shall be and are hereby appropriated for the Regemption of the Loan Warrants, and Treasurers Receipts.

And be it further enacted. That the Monies arising by the Operation of this Act, shall be Accounted for units His Majesty in the Kingdom of Great-Britain and to the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, or High Treasurer for the Time being, and Audited by the Auditor General of His Majesty's Plantations, or his Deputy.
