Pounds; J. Stafford, for O. Stafford, the sum of One Hundred and Thirty-three Pounds; James Stafford, the sum of Thirty-six Pounds, five shillings; J. Detchman, the sum of Sixty Pounds, fourteen shillings.

H. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the said Amount &c. and period Debentures may be issued to the said individuals, in such amounts as for redemption of such debentures. the said Receiver General may deem expedient, and shall bear interest at the rate of six per centum per annum, and be redeemable at the expiration of twenty years from the time of issuing the same, and bear date from the first day of January last.

CHAP. LXIX.

AN ACT to increase the Salary of the Adjutant General of Militia of this Province.

[Passed 11th May, 1839.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

WHEREAS it is expedient to increase the Salary of the Adjutant General of Militia of this Province: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Preamble. most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legisslative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, That 4, Geo. 4, chap so much of the second clause of an Act passed in the fourth year of the partially repealed. reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, entitled "An Act to provide a Salary for the Adjutant General of Militia in this Province, and for other purposes therein-mentioned," as grants to Her Majesty annually the sum of three hundred and sixty-five pounds, to provide a salary for the Adjutant General of Militia of this Province, be and the same is hereby repealed.
