COURT OF REVISION AND COUNCIL MEETING.

Hear Yeage and Escott.

Revision of the assessment roll was made on the 5th inst.

Members all present and were sworn. Mr. Thos. G. Howorth was appointed as chairman.

Appeals made by Mr. John Preston that his assessment was too high compared with adjacent property, and that Melvin Hambly, John Topping, Vance Foley, Fred and Mary Hollingsworth, were too low, were not allowed.

The clerk was authorized to make the following changes in the roll—Geo. Lee put on as owner of C. P. Lot 19, Con. 2, in place of Robert Kearney; Robert Kearney put on as tenant of pt. Lot 18, Con. 2; Edward T. Davis put on for F. E. P. Lot 8, Con. 5, as owner in place of D. L. Kavanaugh; Wm. Neddo assessed for the blacksmith shop property, Lot 2, Con. 8, as owner; Dennis and Muriel Cross put on as owners for the Rebecca Bonsteel farm, E. half Lot 8, Con. 7; Johnston Morris assessed \$1,200 as owner for 60 acres of John Morris' farm, and John Morris' assessment reduced that amount; Benjamin Heferman put on as owner for east half of Lot 23, Con. 8, in place of Stanley Grey. Court was adjourned, and Council business was proceeded with.

Minutes of last regular meeting and a special meeting were read and adopted.

Moved by Chas. B. Howard, seconded by Thos. G. Howorth, that Samuel Spence and James Keyes be allowed to do their road work between Spence's hill and Keyes' Corner.—Carried.

Moved by Chas. B. Howard, seconded by E. S. Earl, that John Morris be allowed to do his road work in division No. 14.—Carried.

Moved by Chas. B. Howard, seconded by G. O. Hayes, that Johnston Morris be allowed to do his road work in division No. 5.—Carried.

Moved by Thos. G. Howorth, seconded by E. S. Earl, that this council purchase 100 cords of stone from Mr. E. Livingston at 30 cents per cord, and accept Thos. Peterson's offer to quarry same for \$2.75 per cord, the stone for maintenance of County road No. 5.—Carried.

A by-law to authorize an overdraft on the Merchants Bank up to \$5,000 was read three times and passed.

Accounts paid: Robt. J. Ferguson, \$6.66 for bonus on 41 rods of wire fence along the highway; F. Blancher \$166.50 for repairing County road; Mortimer Tackaberry, \$27.86 for lumber and labor repairing Foster's creek bridge. The trustees of School Section No. 1 were given an advance of \$180 on their general public school grant.

Moved by G. O. Hayes, seconded by E. S. Earl, that this Council do now adjourn to meet on Saturday, July 3, or sooner if called by the reeve.—Carried.
