A consequence of the American rebellion, which few would have ventured to predict, is the regeneration of India. The check given to the exportation of cotton from the United States, compelled European manfacturers to seek their supplies elsewhere; and the encouragement to industry this given has awak ased the slumbering energies of Egypt and Hladostan. Both countries have become successful growers of cotton on a large scale, within the short space of three years. The effect upon British India is marvellous, though the extent of the change wrought was not quite appreciated till a few days ago, when the Indian Budget was presented to the Imperial Parliament. It then appeared that India within a brief period has exchanged a large deficit in her revenue for a surplus of several hundred thousand pounds per annum; that almost every form of industry is prospering an new before; that agricultural labor is better rewarded and an increased number of arrest are under cultivation; while railways and other internal improvements are pushing forward with energy. All this is sucribed primarily to the stimulus imparted by an active cotton trade, although manufacturer and trader alike still complain of the inferior grades of fibre, which no skill, thus far, has been able to remedy, and which operates to deter the permanent investment of capital in India, from fear of successful vivaly in other countries.
