NOTHING CAN STAY AN ASIATIC INFLUX

Principal of Vancouver College Says We Must Christianize the Orient First.

Two powerful and interesting addresses on the oriental question were delivered before a mass meeting held yesterday afternoon in Queen's Avenue Presbyterian church by Rev. Dr. R. P. McKay, of Toronto, and Principal John McKay, of Vancouver.
