PROCEEDS OF Ladies' Aid social, Niagara Falls South, \$50.

An offer of \$60,000 for the glebe property of St. Andrew's, Ottawa, has been refused.

St. Andrew's congregation, Scarborough, has already contributed \$335 to the China Famine Fund. It is expected that the total contribution will not be less than \$100.

In Prince Edward Island there were in 1839 within the bounds seven congregations; now there are thirty-two. In 1860 the island congregations raised for all purposes \$10,000; last year \$30,000.
