The British board of trade returns, just pub lished, show a continued and remarkable in-crease in British imports from Canada. The figures for March show an increase of £91,520 equal to 576 per cent, as compared with the corresponding period of last year. For the first three months of the year the returns show that the imports from Canada have increased £201,498, equal to 158 per cent. Wheat in-£201,499, equal to 158 per cent. Wheat increased during the quarter £28,600; bacon £9,000; cheese £23,000; fish £122,000; wood £24,-000. During the quarter there were no eggs, butter or metals imported.
