The whole moral law is adjusted to the necessities of our moral and physical nature. It was not originated at Mount Sinai. It was only revealed and reiterated there with solemn and terrifie grandeur. If we ask then, Is the 4th commandment binding on Christians? besides the considerations now suggested, let the Divine Law-giver, Immanuel, reply, "I hink not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil."—Matth. v. 17.

We shall hereafter, if the Lord enable us, point out Scripture examples of Sabbath sanctification, as also the teaching of Scripture in regard to the change of the day from the seventh

to the first day of the week.
