

**ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF
THE CONVENTION ON SOCIAL SECURITY BETWEEN CANADA AND
SPAIN CONCLUDED ON NOVEMBER 10, 1986**

Pursuant to Article 17 of the Convention on Social Security between Canada and Spain, concluded on November 10, 1986, the competent authorities:

for Canada,

the Minister of National Health and Welfare

for Spain,

the Ministry of Labour and Social Security

have agreed on the following provisions:

PART I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

ARTICLE 1

1. For the application of this Administrative Arrangement, "Convention" means the Convention on Social Security between Canada and Spain, signed at Madrid on November 10, 1986.

2. Other terms will have the meaning given to them in the Convention.
