

- (b) export permits and exit visas, as the case may be, for Canadian personnel and their dependents and for materials, professional and technical equipment and the personnel effects of this personnel.

ARTICLE XIII

Any differences which may arise in the application of the provisions of this Agreement or a subsidiary understanding shall be settled by negotiations between the Government of Canada and the Government of Mali or in any other manner mutually acceptable to the Contracting Parties to this Agreement.

ARTICLE XIV

This Agreement shall enter in force on the date of signature by the two Governments and shall remain effective for a period of three (3) years. It will then be automatically renewed from year to year unless it is terminated by a six (6) months advance written notice from either party. However, such termination shall not void the contracts already entered into and guaranties already given under this Agreement.
