b) The second phase will involve a specific response on both bilateral and multilateral levels, based on the report of the assessment team.

We would be in a position to provide the services of Innotech's airborne remote sensing device.

A decision will then be made regarding the shipment of skimmers and booms. We are ready to send this equipment if there is a need. On the multilateral scene, Canada would be involved in coordinated efforts to be established by UNEP, IMO and others.

c) Further down the road, after the war, Canada will assist in the long term correction of the ecological damage. This will be a major endeavour and Canada will do its share.

I trust the above provides additional information of interest to the Standing Committee.
