PRAYERS.

The Clerk of the House laid upon the Table the Third Report of the Clerk of Petitions, stating that he had examined the following petitions presented on the 14th instant, and finds that all the requirements of Standing Order 68 have been complied with in each case, namely:—

Of the Pension Fund Society of the Bank of Montreal, praying for the passing of an Act to amend the Act incorporating it.—*Mr. Jacobs.*

Of Ruth McMaster, of Montreal, Québec, praying for the passing of an Act to declare her marriage with Douglas Stuart McMaster, of Montreal, Quebec, to be dissolved, and that she be divorced from him.—*Mr. Jacobs.*

Mr. Mackenzie (Vancouver Centre), a Member of the King's Privy Council laid before the House,—Copies of Naval General Orders promulgated and issued to the Canadian Naval Forces, February 2, 1936, under the provisions of section 44, chapter 139, R.S.C., 1927.

Also,—Copies of General Orders promulgated to the Militia and Royal Canadian Air Force January 15, 1936, and February 1, 1936, under the provisions of section 141, chapter 132, and chapter 3, section 4 (4), R.S.C., 1927.

And also,—Copy of Order in Council, P.C. 322, dated February 10, 1936, amending Order in Council, P.C. 3315, dated October 22, 1935, passed under the provisions of the Supplementary Public Works Construction Act, 1935—Department of National Defence.

Mr. Rogers, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Copies of Orders in Council passed under the provisions of the Relief Act, 1932, the Relief Act, 1934, and the Relief Act, 1935, as follows:—

Order in Council, P.C. 381, dated February 14, 1936: authorizing payment to the province of Quebec of the sum of \$169.94 for municipal direct relief in organized municipalities in Montmagny county.
