PRAYERS.

One petition for a private bill was presented in accordance with Standing Order 70(1).

Mr. Chown, seconded by Mr. McIlraith, moved,—That Bill SD-199 entitled: “An Act for the relief of William Harrison Terry”, the preamble of which has been reported as not proven, be placed on the Order Paper for consideration at the next sitting of the House.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

Mr. Fleming (Eglinton), seconded by Mr. Green, moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at its next sitting to consider the following proposed resolution which has been recommended to the House by His Excellency:

That it is expedient to introduce a measure to approve certain expenditures authorized in respect of the fiscal year ended on March 31, 1958, including those provided for by the Special Warrants issued by the Governor General pursuant to Orders of the Governor in Council of August 16, 1957 (P.C. 1957-1111), August 19, 1957 (P.C. 1957-1134) and February 7, 1958 (P.C. 1958-222), but not including the expenditures authorized by Appropriation Acts for that fiscal year; and to authorize the application of certain amounts in the accounts of the said fiscal year.

Resolved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at its next sitting to consider the said proposed resolution.
