A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS We are desirous and resolved, as soon as may be, to meet Our
People of Canada, and to have their advice in Parliament:

WE DO MAKE KNOWN Our Royal Will and pleasure to call a Parliament,
and do further declare that by the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, We
have this day given Orders for issuing Our WRITS in due form, for calling a
PARLIAMENT in Canada, which Writs are to bear date of the thirteenth day
of June and to be returnable on the eighth day of October, 1953.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent,
and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: Our
Right Trusty and Well-beloved Counsellor, VINCENT MASSEY, Member of
Our Order of the Companions of Honour, Governor General and Com-
mander-in-Chief of Canada.

AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE, in Our City of Ottawa, Canada, this thirteenth
day of June in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and
fifty-three and in the second year of Our Reign.
