Mr. Cameron (Nanaimo-Cowichan-The Islands), in Committee of the Whole on Bill C-118 (Income Tax Act), moved in amendment to clause 4 the deletion of sub-paragraph (2) from section 12-A and the renumbering of succeeding sub-paragraphs, 303. Ruling of Mr. Lamoureux (Chairman) on point of order—that amendment was out of order in that it imposed a tax—appealed to Mr. Deputy Speaker pursuant to provisional S.O. 59(4) and decision confirmed, 303-4.
