PART I

CANADA MANPOWER AND IMMIGRATION COUNCIL

Council established **3.** There shall be a council to be called the Canada Manpower and Immigration Council, consisting of a Chairman and not more than fifteen members to be appoint-20 ed by the Governor in Council, and each of the chairmen of the advisory boards established under Part II.
