An Act to establish a Canada Manpower and Immigration Council

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Canada Manpower and Immigration Council Act*.

INTERPRETATION

Definitions

2.

In this Act,

“Board”

(a) “board” means an advisory board established under this Act;

“Board member”

(b) “board member” means a member of a board;

“Council”

(c) “Council” means the Canada Manpower and Immigration Council established by this Act;

“Council member”

(d) “Council member” means a member of the Council;

“Department”

(e) “Department” means the Department of Manpower and Immigration; and

“Minister”

(f) “Minister” means the Minister of Manpower and Immigration.

PART I

CANADA MANPOWER AND IMMIGRATION COUNCIL

Council established

3.

There shall be a council to be called the Canada Manpower and Immigration Council, consisting of a Chairman and not more than fifteen members to be appointed by the Governor in Council, and each of the chairmen of the advisory boards established under Part II.
