Right Hon. W. L. MACKENZIE KING (Prime Minister): I think you will agree, Mr. Speaker, that seated where I am, I am in a position to judge whether the Solicitor General was on his feet and had addressed his question to Your Honour before Your Honour put the question to the House—

An hon. MEMBER: You had your back to him.

Mr. MACKENZIE KING: Even with my back to the Solicitor General I heard him say to Mr. Speaker that he wished to raise a point of order before His Honour put the question.

Mr. WOODSWORTH: I should like to say on the point of order that there should be the same rule for to-day as for yesterday. Hansard corroborates the position which I took yesterday. No amenity was shown yesterday.

Mr. SPEAKER: I will state again that I had not seen the Solicitor General. He states that he rose—and I must take his word—before I had put the question. If there is not unanimous consent I must proceed by putting the question.
