MR. MCKENZIE—DELAY IN ANSWERING QUESTIONS

**Mr. Dan McKenzie (Winnipeg South Centre):** Mr. Speaker, there has been undue delay in answering some of my questions which go back to last October. One of them relates to the total cost of the CBC in handling the Manitoba election last October 11. I feel this question should have been answered by now. Also, I have had another question on the order paper since December 7 in reference to whether Liberal members are using the DOT telex to send out political messages. I realize the answer could be embarrassing to the government, but I feel three and a half months should be long enough to enable the government to reply to it.
