## The PROVINCE of QUEBEC.

THIS province is much the largest of any upon the continent. QUEBEC, which is the metropolis, and near the centre of it, is situated in 46 deg. 55 min. north latitude, and 69 deg. 48 min. west longitude; and is bounded north-easterly by the gulf of St. Lawrence, and the river St. John's; north-westerly, by wild uninhabited lands; south-westerly, by the same; and southerly, by the province of New York, the New England provinces, and the province of Nova Scotia, extending from north-east to south-west about sive hundred miles, and is upwards of
